

The Public is hereby informed that due to Major Road Infrastructural works along the Motorway M1, near DesChartes Street, Decaen area, Port Louis, the fast lane of the Motorway M1 of the northbound and southbound carriageway will be closed to traffic. The following Diversion will be in force as from Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2018, until further notice.

1. Traffic coming along the northbound carriageway moving towards Place D'armes, Portlouis will be diverted along two lanes over a length of 200 metres, just after the grade separated junction of Caudan.
2. The slip road joining the northbound carriageway at Caudan grade separated junction will be opened to traffic from Monday to Friday, from 15 00 hours to 18 00 hours only and will remain closed thereafter.
  - a. Traffic from Caudan and Cassis area moving towards the North will be diverted at the level of Caudan Grade separated junction on to Maupin street, Souillac Street John Kennedy street, to join back the Northbound carriageway at Place Darmes.
  - b. Alternately Traffic from Caudan and Cassis area may also use Kwantee street and La Reserve street to join the northbound carriageway at Cassis near Royal College Port Louis.
  - c. Traffic from Port Louis, proceeding towards the North will have to use John Kennedy street and join Motorway M2 at Place D'Armes.
3. Traffic coming along the southbound carriageway moving towards Caudan Grade separated junction, will be diverted along two lanes over a length of 200 metres just after the bus exit from Victoria Bus Terminal
