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Conclusion


- ✓ During the last three years the RDA was undergoing through a transitional period and recovery state and is now a vibrant organization
- ✓ The RDA has identified high added value projects such as Reconstruction of Jumbo Phoenix Roundabout, A1-M1 Bridge and Flyover at DeCaen Street at Port Louis
- ✓ The total spending in road infrastructure has increased nearly two fold since the last two years
- ✓ We intend to increase productivity and achieve the goals set in the Strategic Plan and achieve a step change in terms of resources and capacities
- ✓ In two years time, projects like Jumbo Phoenix Roundabout, A1-M1 Bridge and Flyover at DeCaen Street at Port Louis will be substantially completed
- ✓ Some projects may be substantially small but are high benefits projects eg Southern Bypass, Projects under Maintenance, A10-M1 Link Road at Highlands, La Croisette
- ✓ We will achieve and improve an integrated multi modal transport system with 5 urban terminals integrated with roads eg decongestion of Quatre Bornes, La Vigie La Brasserie and Flic en Flac road projects




ESTIMATES 2018/2019 (Rs M)




