

Revised Executive Summary of Evaluation Report

For the Framework Agreement for Maintenance & Minor Works (2014-2016)

Contract No. CPB/B/RDA/FAM MW/17/13

1. Scope of contract:

The objective of this procurement exercise is to select framework contractors for carrying out Maintenance and Minor Works in connection with roads under the responsibility of the Road Development Authority as well as similar works for other contracting bodies. The works to be executed concern routine and periodic road maintenance works for the RDA including but not limited to resurfacing with asphalt concrete, road upgrading such as construction of footpaths, drains, geometric and structural improvements, realignment of roads, repair & reconstruction of bridges and concrete structures and implementation of road safety measures of all type over a period of two years.

The selection would be on a zonewise basis as follows with no limits on the number of zones quoted by a Contractor subject to corresponding qualification given in the bidding document:

- Zone North - Pamplemousses and Riviere du Rempart;*
- Zone East - Moka and Flacq;*
- Zone Central - Plaines Wilhems, Black River and Port Louis;*
- Zone South - Grand Port and Savanne.*

2. Estimated cost:

Works will be allocated through Call Offs, as and when required for values not exceeding Rs 25M, based on the lowest evaluated price of specific BOQ's calculated using the quoted rates of the contractors selected for a particular zone under the terms and conditions of the framework agreement. The aggregate annual amount of expenditure for the RDA under the Framework agreement is estimated to be in the region of Rs 600m.

3. Funding Agency:

Government of Mauritius, Road development Authority.

4. Procurement method used:

The RDA issued an invitation to eligible and qualified bidders to participate in Framework Agreement for Maintenance and Minor Works (2014-2016) through International Open Advertised International Bidding method.

5. Date of Invitation of bids:

The Bid was advertised on the on 23 December 2013 through International Open Advertised Bidding method.

6. Closing date for submission of bid

The closing date for the submission of bids, initially fixed for Thursday 13th February 2014 at 13.30 hours (local time) at latest at the Central Procurement Board (CPB), was postponed, by Addendum No.2, to Wednesday 5th March 2014.

7. Date and place of opening of bids:

Public Opening was carried out on the same day at 14.00 hours in the Conference Room at the CPB.

8. Number of bids received by closing date:

Eight (8) number of bids were received as listed in table 1 below. All the eight bids were found to have met the bid validity period as per Addendum No. 3 and ITC 18
