**Post:**

Trainee Assistant Inspector of Works

**Salary:**

**Rs 17045 x 260 -17565 (RDA 1)**

**Qualifications:**

- A. Cambridge School Certificate with credit in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics, and one Science or Technical subject obtained at not more than two sittings or Passes not below Grade C in at least five subjects including English Language, Mathematics and one Science or Technical subject obtained at not more than two sittings at the General Certificate of Education “Ordinary Level” provided that at one of the sittings, passes have been obtained either (i) in five subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any two subjects or (ii) in six subjects including English Language with at least Grade C in any one subject.

**NOTE**

Candidates not possessing a credit in English Language at the Cambridge School Certificate will also be considered provided they possess passes in at least two subjects at “Principal Level” and one subject at “Subsidiary Level” as well as the General Paper obtained on one certificate at the Cambridge Higher School Certificate Examinations.

- B. A Cambridge Higher School Certificate with passes at Principal Level in at least three subjects including Mathematics and one Science or Technical subject obtained on one certificate or Passes in at least three subjects including Mathematics and one science or Technical subject obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education “Advanced Level”.

**OR**

Equivalent qualifications to A and B above acceptable to the Board.

Qualifications at A above should have been obtained prior to qualifications at B above.

**Training:**

Trainee Assistant Inspector of Works will be required to undergo two years' on-the-job training, both theoretical and practical, in all aspects of the work of an Assistant Inspector of Works at the end of which they will be required to undergo a work - oriented examination to be conducted in consultation with competent examining bodies.

On successful completion of the training, Trainee Assistant Inspector of Works will be considered for appointment to the grade of Assistant Inspector of Works, as and when vacancies occur.
