Vacancies for post of Surveyor

Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as **Surveyor** in the Road Development Authority.

II. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their **45th** birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

III. QUALIFICATIONS

Candidates should: -

1. By selection from among candidates who are holders of a Land Surveyor's Commission issued under Section 4 of the Land Surveyors Act.
2. be knowledgeable of the Laws and Government Orders regulating to disposal of State Lands and Pas Géométriques.
3. be computer literate.
4. produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.

NOTE

1. **The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case of non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by the closing date.**
2. The Authority reserves the right:
 - (i) to convene qualified candidates for interview; and

(ii) not to make any appointment following this advertisement.

3. In line with promoting gender equity at the Road Development Authority, female candidates are encouraged to apply for the above advertised post.

IV. DUTIES AND SALARY

1. To carry out, in conformity with existing laws, conventions and rules, all land surveys and leveling operations in connection with road projects and allied works.
2. To survey private properties required for acquisitions, sales and exchanges in relation to road projects and allied works.
3. To draw up memoranda of survey and description of land being acquired for road projects and allied works.
4. To perform land acquisition procedures according to the Land Acquisition Act.
5. To carry out searches at the Registrar General's Department or the Archives concerning land ownership.
6. To perform engineering survey on sites of works consisting of confirmation of bench marks, coordinates, limits of properties, road reserves, and taking of spot levels.
7. To ensure that all surveying instrument and equipment used are kept in good running order.
8. To attend to court matters, as and when required.
9. To supervise the work of junior staff working under his responsibility.
10. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from Surveyors in the roles ascribed to them.
